ESPrit 3G Sound Processor is introduced. It is the first processor with a built-in telecoil. Telecoil enables better clarity of sound from phones.




Heather Whitestone McCallum – former Miss America winner - becomes a Cochlear recipient. She is the first woman with a disability to be crowned Miss America.






